



The Colgate Emerging Lecturer Award 2022 Guidelines for Applicants

The Fine Edge of Dentistry Conference
Previously known as 25th RACDS Convocation
8 – 10 September 2022, Melbourne

Applications

1. Applicants **do not** need to be members of the College.
2. Shortlisted applicants will receive complimentary registration to the 2 days of Convocation that the Awards will run over.
3. Applicants **must** have graduated from their first dental qualification within ten (10) years of the Convocation date (September 2022).
4. Applications must be made on the Application Form provided.
5. The closing date for applications is Friday 22 July 2022.
6. Applications will be acknowledged by email.
7. Between three and eight entrants will be chosen to present at Convocation.
8. Each presentation will be 12 minutes in duration, followed by up to 3 minutes for questions from the audience.
9. The presentation **does not** need to be original research; can be **any** topic of choice; if you choose to present original research it **does not** need to have been published.
10. Presentations to be PowerPoint.
11. The winner will be announced as part of the Scientific Program on the last day of Convocation. If shortlisted to present your research, **please ensure you will be present on Saturday 10 September 2022**, as each entrant will receive a Certificate of Achievement with the winner receiving a cheque for AUD\$2,850.
12. Applicants may submit one entry only.

Judging

1. The judging panel will consist of:
 - The College President or nominee.
 - The Dean / Head of an Australasian dental school, or nominee.





- A Fellow of the College or senior academic with extensive lecturing experience.
2. The decision of the judging panel will be final with no right of appeal.
3. The judging panel will assess:
 - Value of lecture (clinical / scientific content) – 40 marks
 - Personal demeanour – 15 marks
 - Use of voice (speed and diction) – 20 marks
 - Use of visual aids and time allocation – 25 marks
